## GALAX CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES April 28, 2003

The Galax City Council convened in regular session on April 28, 2003 at 7:30pm. The mayor called the meeting to order in the courtroom of the WHS Public Safety Building. All councilpersons were present and they are as listed: Odell Hamden, Van McCarter, Sharon Plichta, C. M. Mitchell, Willie Greene, George Valdez and Johnny Lemons.

Councilman Hamden prayed the opening prayer and then he led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman McCarter motioned to dispense with reading the minutes of the last meeting and to approve them as written. Councilman Greene offered a second to the motion and it was unanimously approved.

City Manager Campbell advised that there was no recommendation to be made at this meeting from the Planning Commission on the rezoning of the property at 101 Taylorwood Road.

Councilman Lemons motioned for an executive session at the end of the meeting to make a school board appointment. The motion was seconded and unanimously approved.

Mayor Mitchell advised that this was the date and time duly advertised for a public hearing on the proposed 2003-04 School Budget; he then called for comments. None were received and he declared the hearing closed.

City Manager Campbell stated that no one had contacted him about serving on the Industrial Development Authority.

City Manager Campbell was asked to advertise two vacancies on the Transportation Safety Committee.

City Manager Campbell presented, for approval, a contract with the Galax Health Department. He advised that the contract was in order. Councilman Lemons motioned to approve the contract. Councilman Greene seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Councilman McCarter motioned to appoint Anne Vaughan to another term on the Planning Commission. Councilman Hamden offered a second to the motion and it was unanimously approved.

On a motion by Councilman McCarter, a second by Councilwoman Plichta and unanimous approval, Councilman Greene was appointed to serve on the VML Human Development Committee and City Manager Campbell was appointed to serve on the Finance Committee.

At 7:40 pm Councilman Lemons motioned to go into executive

session as authorize by the Code of Virginia Section 2.2-3711(A)(1) - discussion pertaining to school board appointment. Councilwoman Plichta seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Councilwoman Plichta motioned to return to regular session. Councilman Greene seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

The Certification of Executive Session is made a part of these minutes.

Back in regular session, Councilman Lemons placed all candidates for appointment to the School Board in nomination. A second to this motion was provided by Councilman Hamden.

Councilman McCarter inquired about the mobile classrooms proposed for the Elementary School. School Superintendent Cook addressed the questions raised.
