

GALAX CITY COUNCIL
MEETING
February 11, 2002

The Galax City Council convened in regular session and was called to order by Mayor Mitchell at 7:51 pm on February 11, 2002 in the courtroom of the WMS Public Safety Building. The following councilmen were present and they are as listed: C. M. Mitchell, Odell Hamden, George Valdez and Willie Greene. Councilmen Lemons, Wilson and McCarter were absent from the meeting. Councilman Hamden motioned to dispense with reading the minutes of the last meeting and to approve them as distributed.

Councilman Hamden initiated a discussion of the petition related to abolishing the city treasurer's office.

City Manager Campbell discussed a resolution which addresses an extension of an electric service contract with AEP. The Councilman Hamden stated that VML had done a good job with negotiating with AEP and motioned to approve the resolution as discussed. Councilman Greene offered a second to the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Mr. Campbell presented a VDOT Resolution related to the Glendale Road project. The resolution acknowledges that council members are in agreement with the preliminary design of the project and that right-of-way acquisition be pursued. Councilman Greene motioned to approve said resolution. Councilman Hamden seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

City Manager Campbell outlined the information for refinancing the Regional Landfill debt. He advised that the Regional Authority Board had already approved the refinancing but it also must be approved by the regional governing bodies. Councilman Hamden motioned to adopt the resolution for Galax City Council's approval of said refinancing. Councilman Greene seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Laura Bryant attended tonight's meeting to discuss the library and its programs. She also addressed state funding as it relates to the library.

City Manager Campbell discussed the VDOT 2020 Transportation Plan.

Mr. Campbell advised Council that Turman Hardwood Flooring is in the process of purchasing the former Burruss Company. The company must have the approval of the bankruptcy court which will probably be sometime this month. He also stated that the company is seeking IDA bond assistance through Grayson County and that Council will need to approve an Inducement Resolution. Mr. Campbell noted that the company will manufacture wood flooring

with an estimated 150 employees within the next year and one half.

Councilman Hamden motioned to reappoint Julie Gillespie to a four year term on the Planning Commission. Councilman Greene offered a second to the motion and it was unanimously approved.




